**SUPPLY & INSTALLATION OF MACHINE LAID ASPHALTIC  
 CONCRETE & ASPHALTIC CONCRETE GRINDING.**  
**DATE:** April 30 2002  
**PURPOSE:** To obtain approval to award a contract for machine laid asphalt and asphalt grinding.

**RECOMMENDATION:**

1. **THAT** a contract be awarded to the lowest bidder, Jack Cewe Ltd., for machine laid asphalt and asphalt grinding at various locations throughout Burnaby for a total cost \$2,558,358.23 with final payment based on actual quantities and unit prices tendered.

**REPORT**

Five tenders for this contract were received by the closing time of 3:00 p.m., Wednesday, April 24, 2002 and were opened by staff in the presence of representatives of the firms bidding. The tenders received are as follows:

Jack Cewe Ltd.	\$2,558,358.23
Imperial Paving Ltd.	\$2,622,286.13
Winvan Paving Ltd.	\$2,635,418.47
Columbia Bitulithic Ltd.	\$2,669,062.78
B.A. Blacktop Ltd.	\$2,802,719.08

The work of this contract involves the supply of all labour, materials, tools, plant and equipment required for the grinding of approximately 72,000 square meters of existing asphalt, the laying of approximately 18,000 tonnes of asphalt and other related works. The Director Engineering's estimate for this work is \$2,600,000.

The recommended bidder, Jack Cewe Ltd., has satisfactorily completed numerous projects for the City. The Director Engineering is satisfied that they have the experience and resources to complete the work of this contract.

The Director Engineering concurs with the above recommendation.

This project is included in the 2002-2006 Provisional Capital Program. Appearing elsewhere on the agenda is a work order report recommending funding approval of \$2,086,000.00. The balance of funding is available in existing work orders previously approved by Council.
