Additional Information: The 2003 Capital Budget includes an amount of \$70,000 to facilitate the replacement of poles on Deer Lake Avenue between Sperling Avenue and Deer Lake Parkway. The existing poles are deteriorating and incapable of sustaining wind loading from banners that had been installed several years previously. At present, the banners have been removed. Replacement of these poles with galvanized poles fabricated with heavier steel will allow for the reinstallation of banners. Sufficient General Revenue funds are available and these expenditures are included in the Traffic Management component of the 2003 - 2007 Capital Program.
