**SUBJECT: HERITAGE PLAQUE FOR SHEARER HOUSE**

RECOMMENDATION:

1. **THAT** Council authorize funding up to \$200 for the manufacture and installation of a bronze heritage plaque at the J.D. Shearer House located at 5573 Buckingham Avenue.

**REPORT**

The Community Heritage Commission, at its meeting held on 2003 July 17, received a request from the owners of a designated heritage building known as the J.D. Shearer House at 5573 Buckingham Avenue for the supply and installation of a bronze heritage building plaque.

The Community Heritage Commission has an existing budget to fund the manufacture and installation of heritage plaques with Council authorization. In 2002 Council approved the expenditure of funds for the creation of a new design for bronze heritage plaques and the manufacture of a plaque commemorating the Floden House.

It is estimated that the option of providing the Shearer House with a designated building plaque would cost approximately \$200.00. As this building does not currently have a building plaque and has been recently restored by the owners, a new City of Burnaby bronze plaque is recommended by staff.

Funds are available in the Community Heritage Commission budget.
