**RECOMMENDATION:**

1. "THAT Council authorize the printing of 200 copies of "Life With The Moores of Hart House" at an estimated cost of \$3,400.00."

**REPORT**

The Community Heritage Commission is pleased to advise that the first printing of the book "Life With The Moores Of Hart House" (100 copies) sold out in less than two weeks. In 2002 December, the "Burnaby Now" published an article which helped to sell the last few books through the Burnaby Village Museum. The funds received from sales of the first printing covered the cost of that printing, with a small surplus.

In preparation for a second printing, Mr. Harry Pride, the author, has been making presentations to Senior Recreation Centres, Senior Care Residences, the Burnaby Historical Society and the Retired Teachers Associations. He has received a very positive response, which has resulted in close to 100 orders for the next printing. To further promote the second printing, information about the book and its availability may be published in the "News Leader", "Burnaby Now" and the "InfoBurnaby". Additional books from the second printing will be available from the Cashier at City Hall for a purchase price of \$17.00 (including tax).

Funds are available in the Community Heritage Commission budget. However, it is anticipated that the 200 copies will be sold over a reasonable period of time and again the money raised through the sale of the books is anticipated to cover the entire cost of the project.
