**PENZANCE DRIVE STABILIZATION WORKS**  
**PURPOSE:** To obtain approval to award a contract for the construction of a slope stabilization berm at the Chevron Refinery along Penzance Drive.

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**RECOMMENDATION:**

1. **THAT** a contract be awarded to the lowest bidder, Mission Contractors Ltd., for the construction of a stabilization berm at the Chevron Refinery along Penzance Drive for a total cost of \$808,600.05 with final payment based on actual quantities and unit prices tendered.

**REPORT**


Ten tenders for this contract were received by the closing time of 3:00 p.m., Thursday June 26, 2003 and were opened by staff in the presence of representatives of the firms bidding. The tenders received are as follows:

The work of this contract involves the construction of a stabilization berm within the active operations area of Chevron Canada's Burnaby Refinery adjacent to Penzance Drive. The Director Engineering's estimate for this work is \$1,400,000.

The recommended bidder, Mission Contractors Ltd., has satisfactorily completed several projects for the City. The Director Engineering is assured that they have the experience and resources to complete the work of this contract. The Director Engineering and our consultant, Associated Engineering (BC) Ltd., concur with the above recommendation.

Appearing elsewhere on this agenda is a Bylaw seeking funding for this project. These expenditures are included in the Special Roads component of the 2003-2007 Capital Program.
