**SUBJECT: CRIME PREVENTION THROUGH ENVIRONMENTAL DESIGN  
(CPTED) REVIEW OF METROTOWN CENTRE AND  
METROPOLIS AT METROTOWN**

**RECOMMENDATION:**

1. THAT Council authorize staff to undertake a comprehensive Crime Prevention Through Environmental Design (CPTED) Review, during the redevelopment process of Metrotown Centre and Metropolis at Metrotown involving the shopping centre developer, TransLink, City of Burnaby and the RCMP Southwest Community Policing District to address safety issues at the Metrotown transit area, the Skytrain Station, and the food court within the shopping centre.

**REPORT**

At its meeting of 2003 June 12, the Community Policing Committee considered a request from the Burnaby-New Westminster Task Force on the Sexual Exploitation of Children and Youth to forward a recommendation to Council regarding possible safety improvements to the Metrotown bus loop. The Task Force, a subcommittee of the Community Policing Committee, is a multi-agency group which works to prevent the recruitment of young people into the sex trade.

Ensuing from its discussion of the request, the Community Policing Committee recommended that during the redevelopment process of Metrotown Centre and Metropolis at Metrotown a comprehensive Crime Prevention Through Environmental Design (CPTED) Review, involving the shopping centre developer, TransLink, City of Burnaby, and the RCMP Southwest Community Policing District, be undertaken to address safety issues at the Metrotown transit area, the Skytrain Station, and the food court within the shopping centre.
