SUBJECT: BURNABY TENNIS CLUB
(AIR SUPPORT STRUCTURE) LICENSE RENEWAL

RECOMMENDATIONS:

REPORT

The City has had an agreement with the Burnaby Tennis Club since approximately 1982, providing the opportunity for installation of an air support structure annually for a maximum of seven months during the period October 1st to April 30th. The Burnaby Tennis Club continues to provide a valuable service to the community and operates within the terms and conditions of their license. The conditions of the license have been reviewed with the President and members of the Burnaby Tennis Club, and the following changes are proposed for the new five year term:

1. The new term for the license will be for five years commencing on the 1st day of October, 2003 and ending on the 30th day of April, 2008.
2. Insurance requirements will be amended to comply with City standards.

It is recommended that approval be given for the renewal of the license agreement as outlined in this report.
