**TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES -VARIOUS LOCATIONS**

**PURPOSE:** To obtain approval for the installation of traffic control devices at various locations within the City.

**RECOMMENDATION:**

1. **THAT** a contract be awarded to the lowest bidder, Bay Hill Contracting Ltd., for the supply and installation of traffic control devices for a total cost of \$389,073.40 with final payment based on actual quantities and unit prices tendered.

**REPORT**



Three tenders for this contract were received by the closing time of 3:00 p.m., Tuesday, July 29, 2003 and were opened by staff in the presence of representatives of the firms bidding. The tenders received are as follows:

Bay Hill Contracting Ltd.	\$389,073.40
Trans Western Electric Ltd.	\$412,986.83
Imperial Electric Ltd.	\$491,472.40

The work of this contract involves the supply of all labour, materials, tools, plant and equipment required for the supply and installation of traffic control devices at various locations within the City. The Director Engineering's estimate for this work is \$440,000.00.

The recommended bidder, Bay Hill Contracting Ltd., has satisfactorily completed similar projects for the City and the Director Engineering is satisfied that they have the experience and resources to complete the work of this contract. The Director Engineering concurs with the above recommendation.

Partial funding is available in work orders previously approved by Council. Appearing elsewhere on the agenda is a Bylaw seeking additional funding for the remainder of these projects.
