# **RECOMMENDATION:**

1. THAT Council be requested to authorize the sale for moving or salvage or demolition of the structures including outbuildings at 9723 Cameron Street.

## REPORT

The Director Engineering has requested that the removal and/or demolition of the City-owned structure and all outbuildings at 9723 Cameron Street be put forward for consideration by the Parks, Recreation and Culture Commission and City Council. The subject property was acquired in September of 1987 for inclusion in Cameron Park and has been held as a rental property in the interim until required for park development. The subject property is located at the east end of Cameron Park and is the only remaining rental property at this site (Attachment #1).

The residential dwelling on the subject property is an untenanted older one storey house with crawl space and wood frame structure. The building is in poor condition and extensive repairs would have to be undertaken in order to bring the dwelling to current City rental standards. Finance Department staff have inspected the building and concur that the condition of the building warrants its demolition.

Heritage Planning staff have assessed the dwelling and concluded that there is no heritage value associated with the building.

Parks staff have no objection to the proposed removal and/or demolition, and recommend Commission and Council approval of the Director Engineering's request.
