REPORT


A request to use City streets for a mock crash on Thursday, 2003 May 08 has been received from Cst. Raf Alvarez of the Burnaby RCMP. Council approval is required by the Street & Traffic Bylaw.

The Burnaby RCMP along with ICBC wish to close down Armstrong Ave from Cumberland to Cariboo on Thursday, 2003 May 08 from 11:00am to 1:30pm to stage a mock car crash at the entrance to the student parking lot on Armstrong at Cariboo Hill Secondary School. The mock car crash will involve two vehicles in a "t-bone" collision configuration. Emergency vehicles will be present besides the RCMP.

The organizers are aware that approval is subject to the following conditions:

1. That the road closure be conducted under the supervision of one person as marshall or organizer.
2. That all participants be instructed to respect the rights and property of the individuals encountered en route.

As the RCMP are self insured, no liability insurance is required.
