**REPORT**

In September 2002, Council received correspondence from the Minister of Community, Aboriginal and Women's Services advising of a change in the way in which the Ministry manages provincial appointments to Boards of Variance. The change in policy requires the City of Burnaby to submit two names to the Provincial Government from which one appointee will be selected.

Advertisements were placed in the February 2<sup>nd</sup> and February 5<sup>th</sup> editions of both the Burnaby Now and The News Leader seeking nominees to be submitted to the Provincial Government for consideration for an appointment to the Board of Variance. A review of all applications received as well as the applications from the unsuccessful volunteers for the Council appointment, was undertaken and as a result of that process, the above noted recommendation is submitted for Council's consideration.
