**PURPOSE:** To present the 2002 Financial Statements to Council.

## **RECOMMENDATION:**

## **REPORT**

Enclosed with Council's agenda is the 2002 Financial Report which includes the audited financial statements for the year ended 2002 December 31. These statements reflect the accounts of all funds of the City on a consolidated basis. Financial transactions in individual funds are combined and any inter-fund balances and transactions are eliminated. This presentation emphasizes the City's ability to meet its current commitments and finance its future liabilities as reflected in the Net Financial Assets. This number in turn is equal to the City's total reserve fund balances (which included land inventory valued at cost).

The City budgets on a fund basis. The following is the net fund surpluses from operations for 2002:
