REPORT

The Community Heritage Commission at its meeting held on 2004 February 05 requested that funding be made available for the City of Burnaby to host the 2004 Heritage Society of British Columbia 26th Annual Conference in June.

The Heritage Society of B.C. Conference will be held on Friday, June 04 from 9 to 4 p.m. at the Shadbolt Centre for the Arts. This will be the first time that the City of Burnaby will be the host of this event and have the opportunity to showcase Burnaby's heritage program and the heritage precinct of Deer Lake Park. The conference titled "Cultural Landscapes: Precincts, Places and Parks" will include speakers that are authorities on the conservation of cultural landscapes. Deer Lake Park will form an important part of the conference for outdoor workshops and tours.

The funds requested are to provide Burnaby's Community Heritage Commission the opportunity to host the delegates on a full day tour through Deer Lake Park, and highlight the city-owned heritage sites such as the Ceperley House, Eagles Estate Heritage Garden and Burnaby Village Museum. The Hart House Restaurant has graciously provided the city with opportunity to host a luncheon for delegates as part of the tour.

Funds are available in the Community Heritage Commission budget.
