Additional Information: The City has an annual pavement overlay program to restore deteriorated asphalt surfaces and extend the useful life of the pavement. This form of treatment is an integral part of infrastructure renewal that protects the City's significant investment in the road network. The program includes rehabilitation of sections of the Major Roads Network that are funded by TransLink. Sufficient General Revenue funds are available and these expenditures are included in the Street and Lane Rehabilitation component of the 2004 - 2008 Provisional Capital Program.

Additional Information: This work order provides funding for replacement watermains on streets that form part of the annual pavement rehabilitation program.
