Additional Information: Appearing elsewhere on this agenda is an item recommending the award of Contract 2004-24: Culvert Rehabilitation (2004 Program). This contract consists essentially of rehabilitating drainage culverts and replacement of inlet and outlet structures at various locations. Total estimated project cost of \$220,000, including minor miscellaneous drainage improvement works by city forces, exceeds current budget allocation by \$22,000. However, sufficient General Revenue funds are available for project completion and appropriate adjustments will be made to ensure Capital Budget spending limits are not exceeded.
