**RECOMMENDATION:**

**REPORT**

At its meeting of 2004 February 09 the Executive Committee of Council received a delegation from Mr. Denis Lysack and Ms. Jay McGarva of the Burnaby Symphony Orchestra. They presented information on a special initiative the Symphony was promoting. "Young Artists of the Future" (Attachment #1) is a special evening dedicated to promoting solo artists between the ages of 8 and 14 years.

The request from the organization is to cover the costs associated with this event. This is a fundraising recital for the Symphony and promotes young talent from the region.

Staff have reviewed the benefits and associated cost and feel this is a worthwhile event which showcases the cultural aspect of our community. The event was held 2004 April 10, and the organizers reported that approximately 300 people attended. They were unable to report on the success of the fundraising as they are finalizing the expenses.

The financial request is for \$4,800 (Attachment #2). Based on similar requests, it is recommended that a grant of \$2,400 be given to cover the costs associated with the event. This is a one time only grant.
