**PURPOSE:** 

To request Council authority to set a minimum bid price for a site proposed for

sale by the City

## **RECOMMENDATION:**

1. THAT the subject City owned multi-family site be offered for sale by public tender in accordance with the conditions of sale authorized in this report.

## REPORT

The subject 2.09 acre multi-family site shown on the attached sketch #1 is serviced and ready for sale. The development guidelines were previously adopted by Council in November, 2004.

## Valuation

In order to set a minimum bid price a number of sales of development sites in Burnaby were analyzed as follows:

On sites with a similar density, values in the \$32 - \$60/sq. ft. range were found. Prices varied depending on location, size of site, ease of construction, sale date and DCC's. It is, therefore recommended that a minimum bid price of \$4,550,000.00 (\$49.91/sq. ft.) be set in order to attract a number of competitive bids.

## **Conditions of Sale**


- (a) Agreement by purchaser to abide by development guidelines and to complete an amendment CD rezoning;
- (b) A deposit in the amount of 5% of the bid price is to be submitted at the time of bidding;
- (c) The purchaser will be required to complete the transaction within six months of the ratification of their bid by Council;
- (d) At the time of completion the City will collect a payment in lieu of taxes for the remainder of the year based on the sale price and date of completion. Subsequent years' taxes will be as per the same calculation until such time as the property is on the tax roll.
