SUBJECT: **CONTRACT NO. 2004-13 - PEDESTRIAN SERVICES - SKYTRAIN SIDEWALKS
 TEXACO DRIVE AT CPR MAINLINE**
PURPOSE: To obtain approval to award a contract for the construction of pedestrian services at various locations within the City.

RECOMMENDATION:

1. **THAT** a contract be awarded to the lowest bidder, Imperial Paving Ltd., for the construction of pedestrian services for a total cost of \$525,778.74 with final payment based on actual quantities and unit prices tendered.

REPORT


Six tenders for this contract were received by the closing time of 3:00 p.m., Monday April 26, 2004 and were opened by staff in the presence of representatives of the firms bidding. The tenders received are as follows:

The work of this contract involves the supply of all labour, materials, tools, plant and equipment required for the construction of curbing, sidewalks, storm sewers, streetlighting, traffic signals, landscaping and other related works at three locations along the Loughheed Highway Skytrain line as well as Texaco Drive at the CPR mainline. The Director Engineering's estimate for this work is \$561,750.00

The recommended bidder, Imperial Paving Ltd., has satisfactorily completed numerous projects for the City. The Director Engineering is satisfied that they have the experience and resources to complete the work of this contract. The Director Engineering and our consultant, McElhanney Consulting services Ltd., concur with the above recommendation.

Sufficient funds are available and this project is included under the Engineering Major Roads and Major Parks components of the 2004-2008 Annual Capital Program. Partial funding is available in work orders previously approved by Council. Appearing elsewhere on the agenda is a report seeking additional funding for the Major Parks component of this contract.
