**PURPOSE:** To seek funding approval for the reconstruction of 10<sup>th</sup> Avenue from Kingsway to 18<sup>th</sup> Street.



**RECOMMENDATIONS:**

1. THAT Council authorize bringing forward a Capital Works Expenditure Bylaw in the amount of \$50,000 for engineering services related to the reconstruction of 10<sup>th</sup> Avenue, within the Burnaby half of the right of way, between Kingsway and just west of 18<sup>th</sup> Street

**R E P O R T**

The City plans to reconstruct 10<sup>th</sup> Avenue, within the Burnaby half of the right of way, between Kingsway and just west of 18<sup>th</sup> Street with construction tentatively scheduled for next year. Consultancy services are required to prepare detailed engineering designs over the winter period in expectation of tender calls in Spring 2005. Cost of the required engineering services is estimated at \$50,000 (inclusive of 7% GST). It is recommended that a Capital Reserve Expenditure Bylaw be brought down in this amount. Sufficient Capital Reserves are available and these expenditures are included in the Major Roads component of the 2005 Capital Program. It is recommended that \$50,000 be brought forward to 2004 to allow for design services to proceed in anticipation of an early tender call in 2005. Appropriate adjustments would be made to ensure approved spending limits for 2004 are not exceeded.
