PURPOSE: To obtain approval to award a contract for soil remediation at the former target ranges located on the Barnet Highway

RECOMMENDATION:

1. **THAT** a contract be awarded to the lowest bidder, Golder Associates Innovative Applications (GAIA) Inc., for soil remediation at a total cost of \$1,827,426.44 with final payment based on actual quantities and unit prices tendered.

REPORT

Three tenders for this contract were received by the closing time of 3:00 p.m. Monday, August 8, 2005 and were opened by staff in the presence of representatives of the firms bidding. The tenders received are as follows:

Quantum Remediation Inc.	\$2,155,711.88
Hazco Environmental Services Ltd.	\$2,764,648.22


The work of this contract involves soil remediation, on site secure landfill, construction of sediment traps, maintenance roads, a parking lot, landscaping work and other miscellaneous and related restoration work. Engineering has evaluated these tenders and is of the opinion that they are competitive and reflective of current conditions.

The recommended bidder, Golder Associates Innovative Applications (GAIA) Inc., has completed similar projects in the past. Based on this information, the Director Engineering is satisfied that they have the experience and resources to successfully complete the scope of this contract.
