

Additional Information: These work orders provide funding for the ongoing program of improvements to existing pump station alarm and data acquisition systems. These systems enable staff to remotely monitor alarms and respond in a timely manner in the event of a station malfunction as well as remotely gather data on system operating characteristic. Sufficient General Revenue funds are available and these expenditures are included in the Sewer and Water Utility components of the 2005-2009 Capital Program

60-32-125 Stormwater Management Study – Willingdon / Carleton Area \$100,000

Charge: 2005 Provisional Capital Budget
Storm Drainage

Additional Information: The 2005 Capital Program includes provision for a stormwater management study of the Carleton drainage area. The study will examine the network of existing drainage facilities and alternatives to manage runoff in the watershed. Sufficient General Revenue funds are available and these expenditures are included in the Storm Drainage component of the 2005-2009 Capital Program
