**PHASE 3 WORKS**

**RECOMMENDATION:**

- 1. **THAT** a contract be awarded to the lowest bidder, Imperial Paving Ltd., for Byrne Creek dyke improvements for a total cost of \$359,804.62 with final payment based on actual quantities and unit prices tendered.

**REPORT**

Three tenders for this contract were received by the closing time of 3:00 p.m. Monday, June 6, 2005 and were opened by staff in the presence of representatives of the firms bidding. The tenders received are as follows:

Imperial Paving Ltd.	\$359,804.62
Mission Contractors Ltd.	\$521,608.45
J.S. Ferguson Construction Inc.	\$658,435.20

The work of this contract involves Byrne Creek dyke improvements between the CPR right of way and Fraser River, 30 m section of dyke downstream of Byrne Road and other related works. The Director Engineering has evaluated these tenders and is of the opinion that they are competitive and reflective of current conditions.

The recommended bidder, Imperial Paving Ltd., has satisfactorily completed numerous projects for the City. The Director Engineering is satisfied that they have the experience and resources to successfully complete the work of this contract. The Director Engineering and our consultant, Associated Engineering (B.C.) Ltd., concur with the above recommendation.

This project is included under the Engineering Storm Drainage component of the 2005-2009 Annual Capital Program. Appearing elsewhere on the agenda is a Capital Works Bylaw report seeking funding approval for this project.
