RECOMMENDATION:

1. THAT Council be requested to authorize the sale for moving or salvage or demolition of the structures and all outbuildings at 9070 Cameron Street.

REPORT

The Director Engineering has requested that the removal and/or demolition of the City-owned structure and all outbuildings at 9070 Cameron Street be put forward for consideration by the Parks, Recreation and Culture Commission and Council. The subject property was acquired in January 2005 for inclusion in Bell Park. The subject property is located mid block on the south side of the 9000 block Cameron Street to the north of the park as illustrated in the attached sketch (Attachment #1).

The residential dwelling on the subject property is an untenanted older one storey home with an unfinished basement and open garage. The building is in poor condition. Finance Department Staff have concluded that it is not economically feasible to renovate the house for rental purposes and Engineering Department staff concur that the condition of the building warrants its demolition.
