SUBJECT: PROPOSED PEDESTRIAN OVERPASS AT GRIFFITHS DRIVE
PURPOSE: To seek approval to bring down a Development Cost Charges Reserve Fund Expenditure Bylaw to finance detailed design of the proposed pedestrian overpass at Griffiths Drive.

RECOMMENDATION:

1. **That** a Development Cost Charges Reserve Fund Expenditure Bylaw in the amount of \$250,000 (inclusive of 7% GST) be brought down to finance the detailed design of the proposed Pedestrian Overpass as outlined in this report.

REPORT

The 2005 Capital Program includes provision for the design of the Griffiths Drive pedestrian overpass near 14th Avenue that forms part of the proposed Urban Trail which will provide access from the developing Edmonds Town Centre South residential community to the new Byrne Creek Secondary School. Consultancy services are required to prepare detailed engineering designs and construction contract documentation. Total cost of the engineering services is estimated at \$250,000 (inclusive of 7% GST). These expenditures are included in the Urban Trail component of the 2005 Annual Financial Plan. The expenditure bylaw appears elsewhere on Council agenda.
