

RECOMMENDATION:

1. THAT Council be requested to authorize the sale for moving or salvage or demolition of the structures including all outbuildings at 5290 Watling Street.

REPORT

The Director Engineering has requested that the removal and/or demolition of the City-owned structure at 5290 Watling Street be put forward for consideration by the Parks, Recreation and Culture Commission and Council. The subject property was acquired on 1991 July 17 for inclusion in both McPherson Park and the Burnaby South Secondary School site. Since its acquisition by the City, the property has been held as a residential rental property. The property is situated on the south side of Watling Street in the undeveloped portion of McPherson Park located to the west of Burnaby South Secondary School as illustrated in Sketch #32 (Attachment 1).

The residential dwelling on the subject property is a tenanted small older bungalow with an unfinished basement and detached carport. The building is in poor condition and extensive repairs would have to be undertaken to bring the dwelling to current City rental standards. Finance Department staff conducted an inspection and rental analysis and concluded that it is not economically feasible to carry out major repairs to the building for rental purposes. Engineering Department staff concur that the condition of the building warrants its demolition. The tenant has been informed of the situation and has secured alternative accommodation.

Heritage Planning staff have been consulted and confirm that there is no heritage value associated with the building.
