The South Burnaby United Church is requesting the use and closure of the road and laneway in the rear of their property (7591 Gray) and Gray Avenue from Watling to Rumble, see attached map, for their fifth Fall Festival on Saturday, 2005 September 17.


The festival will allow their neighbours an opportunity to meet and participate in their various events through the day.

1. That the road and lane closure be conducted under the supervision of one person as marshall or organizer.

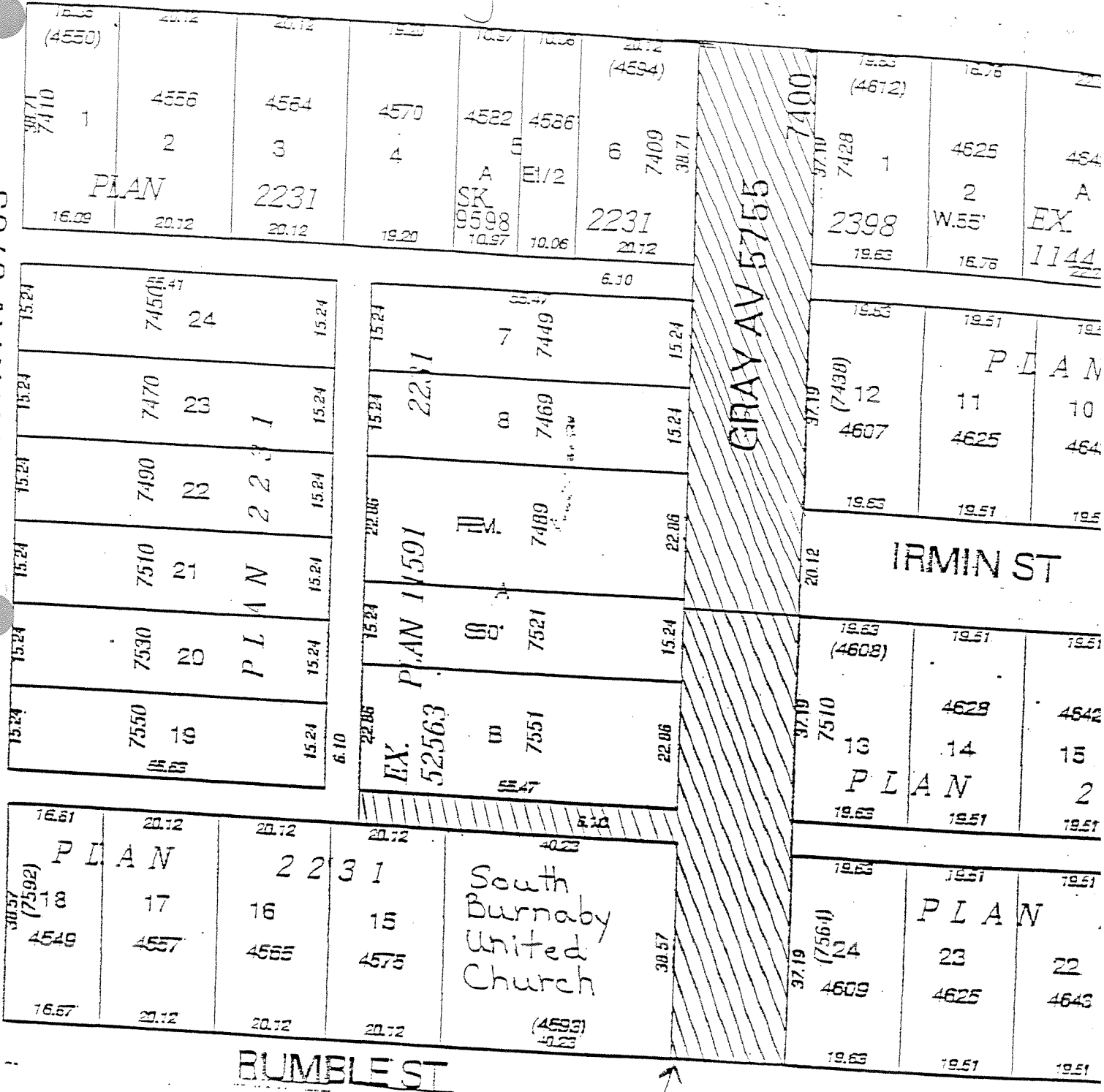
