SUBJECT: FUNDING FOR PC/PERIPHERAL REQUIREMENTS


PURPOSE: Approval to bring down a Capital Reserves Expenditure Bylaw for PC/Peripheral Requirements

RECOMMENDATION:

1. **THAT** A Capital Reserves Expenditure Bylaw in the amount of \$14,000 (inclusive of GST @ 6%) be brought down to finance the purchase of new PC/Peripherals for the Burnaby Public Library system.

REPORT

Burnaby Public Library is requesting \$14,000 from the City of Burnaby's Capital Reserves to fund the purchase of a number of PCs and computer peripherals. This computer equipment will allow library patrons and staff to optimize the use of the Library's Integrated Library System (ILS). The Library's Automation Reserves are insufficient to fund the purchase of this equipment as the current reserve has been depleted as a result of having to replace stolen equipment as well as replace a significant amount of aging equipment. This funding is included as part of the 2006 Capital Program.
