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**RECOMMENDATION:**

1. **THAT** a contract be awarded to the lowest bidder, Double M Excavating Ltd., for intersection improvements at Marine Way and Nelson Avenue for a total cost \$1,394,769.61 with final payment based on actual quantities and unit prices tendered.

**REPORT**

Three tenders for this contract were received by the closing time of 3:00 p.m. Thursday May 18, 2006 and were opened by staff in the presence of representatives of the firms bidding. The tenders received are as follows:

Double M Excavating Ltd.	\$1,394,769.61
Imperial Paving Ltd.	\$1,494,924.49
Targa Contracting Ltd.	\$1,650,079.10

The work of this contract involves the supply of all labour, materials, tools, plant and equipment required for construction of road works, raised median, drainage, street lighting, traffic signals and other related works. The Director Engineering is of the opinion that the tenders received are competitive and reflective of current market conditions.

The recommended bidder, Double M Excavating Ltd., has not done work for the City previously. Reference checks reveal that they have the experience and resources to complete the work of this contract. The Director Engineering and our consultant, Delcan Corporation concur with the above recommendation.
