**REPORT**

At its meeting on 2006 May 08, Council adopted the recommendation to approve Terms of Reference for the Mayor's Task Force on Graffiti. The purpose of the Task Force will be to examine best practices and innovative ideas on the prevention of graffiti in Burnaby.

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Based on its findings, the Task Force will make recommendations to Council on a proposed strategy to combat graffiti in Burnaby. The work of the Task Force will include (but not be limited to) examining:

- best practices in eradicating graffiti (e.g., graffiti control bylaws, assistance for the victims of graffiti vandalism, graffiti removal on public property and utilities).
- best practice in policing graffiti vandals.
- innovative preventative measures (e.g., public education and awareness, mural programs, community clean-ups).

The Task Force will be chaired by Councillor Colleen Jordan. The Task Force will present a proposed strategy for combating graffiti within six months of its inception. The first meeting will take place on 2006 June 15.


In accordance with the Terms of Reference, Council is requested to approve the appointments of the following persons to the Mayor's Task Force on Graffiti:
