Charge: 2006 Annual Capital Program
Sanitary Extensions \$75,000

Additional Information: The City has an ongoing program to reduce infiltration and inflow in the sanitary sewer system. Reduction of infiltration and inflow lessens the load on sewerage treatment plants and is a critical element in the Regional Liquid Waste Management Plan (LWMP).

Elements of the proposed program include:

- infiltration and inflow data collection and reporting as mandated under the LWMP;
- video camera inspection to identify specific areas of the sewer system that may require rehabilitation;
- collecting dry-weather flow data for ongoing sewer model calibration.

Total cost of engineering services is estimated at \$75,000. Sufficient General Revenue funds are available and these expenditures are included in the Sanitary Sewer Utility component of the 2006 – 2010 Annual Financial Plan.
