### REPORT

### A. **BACKGROUND**

Each spring Commission receives a report outlining the recommended fee structure for the upcoming year's parks, recreation and cultural services. Fees are established at this time to enable staff to better project revenues during the Provisional Budget process. The new 2006/2007 rates will be advertised in the Fall/ Winter Leisure Guide, to be distributed in August.

Market research on comparable admission rates, programs and services throughout the Lower Mainland is conducted annually to ensure that the City of Burnaby fees remain reasonable and competitive.

Based on this research and analysis, it is recommended that the Facility User Fees and Program and Service Fees increase 2.5% in most areas. This increase is applicable to all bylaw and non-bylaw fees. The 2.5% increase is necessary to offset inflationary increases in supply costs. There are exceptions to the recommended increase that are primarily based on fluctuations in the market or increased costs. These exceptions are detailed in the following information.

The current practice of rounding rates to the nearest nickel will be continued for the ease of cash handling. Fees may vary from the attachments if there are future GST changes.

The fees and charges process consists of the following two aspects:

### 1. Burnaby Facility Use Fee Schedule Bylaw

This document is required under the conditions of the Community Charter. The bylaw covers all fees and charges related to admissions and allotment or rental usage of recreation/ culture buildings and facilities. The bylaw is established on an annual basis and does not cover program registration fees.

Due to its size, the proposed 2006/2007 Facility Use Fee Schedule has been provided as a separate package (Attachment "A")

### 2. Program and Service Fees

The second aspect is the document that establishes the rates for registered programs and services. The Program and Service Fees document has been provided as a separate package (Attachment "B")

In 1997, Commission approved a Value Statements document (<u>Attachment "C"</u>) and an Operating Principles document (<u>Attachment "D"</u>), that forms the pricing guidelines that provides a framework for fees and charges and guidance to staff for establishing rates for registered programs and services.

### B. CHANGES TO FEES THAT DIFFER FROM THE INFLATIONARY INCREASE

### Proposed Adjustments to the 2006/2007 Facility Use Fee Schedule Bylaw

### a. Increases Above Inflation

Staff conduct surveys to determine market range and recommend fees which are fair market price. The market price reflects the effects of supply and demand on the service area. The following areas are currently not in the mid market range.

### b. New Fees

New fees are developed for service areas to reflect changing trends, consumer demands, or may be the result of a re-structuring of a service area. The following new fees are being recommended:

Artificial Turf Fields

- Hourly rate for tournaments

- Archery club range fee - "Hoods Up Flyers" club fee

Pass program for admissions

- 4 month option to replace the 3 month and

6 month pass options

Burnaby Village Museum

- Half price Tuesdays

### c. Fee Deletions

It is recommended that the following fees be deleted.

Pass program for admissions

- All 3 month and 6 month options

Squash/ Racquetball courts

- Non-prime time court rentals

Willingdon Centre

- Private and preferred social rate

### d. Maintain Current Fee

The following fees are at the high end of the market range and so no increase is being recommended:

Bill Copeland Sports Centre Ice Rental - community group prime and non prime time

- private and commercial prime time

Bonsor/Eastburn/Edmonds- Allotments - multipurpose room prime and non prime time

### e. Decreased Fees

It is recommended that the following fees be decreased:

Squash/Racquetball Courts
 Burnaby Lake Pavilion - social
 Decreased to fit new lifestyle pass
 Decreased during dredging only

Arenas - Helmet/skate rental decrease to be more affordable as part of the loonie skate

### Proposed Adjustments to 2006/2007 Program and Service Fees

Staff also conducts market surveys and comparisons for these Program and Service fees. The majority of the non-bylaw fees will increase by the inflationary rate only. Exceptions are recommended when current fees are not within the market range or program costs have significantly increased. Occasionally a re-design of a service area may be recommended in order to keep current with trends or to implement a re-structuring strategy. These structural changes can impact fees also.

### a. Increases above Inflation

The following program areas have experienced an increase in costs and/or are not within mid-market range.

### b. New Fees

The following new non-bylaw fees are being recommended:

• Outdoor Programs

- Kayaking

- Small craft and paddlesport navigation.

- Snowshoeing

• Arena Programs

- School and group ice skate rentals

- Semi private lessons

- Car trunk sale - parking & table

### c. Fee Deletions

The following fee area is recommended for deletion due to insufficient demand.

Personal training

- Semi private single session

### d. Decreased Fees

The following fee is being recommended for decrease as the current fee was at the high end of the market.

Pilates

- Service hour rate

### **SUMMARY**

According to local market research as well as to the British Columbia Parks and Recreation Association survey of programs and services fees, the proposed 2006/2007 Facility Use Fee Schedule and Program and Service Fees are reasonably priced. The recommended adjustments will assist in providing the best possible service to Burnaby residents at appropriate rates for convenient, quality services. In addition, with fair and competitive fees, sufficient revenue is generated to offset inflationary increases.

### **FEES AND CHARGES VALUES STATEMENTS**

WHILE IT IS RECOGNIZED THAT <u>ALL</u> RECREATIONAL SERVICES ARE SUPPORTED BY SOME DEGREE OF SUBSIDIZATION, THE FOLLOWING VALUES REFLECT SPECIFIC AREAS WHICH WILL RECEIVE HIGHER LEVELS OF SUBSIDY:

- THE IMPORTANCE OF RECREATIONAL ACTIVITIES TO CERTAIN AGE GROUPS IS RECOGNIZED.
  - There is a great long term benefit to the community when preschoolers, children, and youth are involved in recreational activities.
  - Seniors' mental and physical health is greatly enhanced through their participation in recreational activities.
- THE PROMOTION AND CELEBRATION OF COMMUNITY SPIRIT AND CULTURAL HARMONY THROUGH PARTICIPATION IN RECREATIONAL OPPORTUNITIES IS VERY IMPORTANT TO THE HEALTH OF THE BURNABY COMMUNITY.
  - Services which include the opportunity for involvement of community members in the planning and leading of a recreational activity will receive greater level of subsidization.
- PARKS AND RECREATION PROGRAMS AND SERVICES ARE ESSENTIAL TO THE WELL-BEING OF THE COMMUNITY THEREFORE THEY NEED TO BE AFFORDABLE.
  - Community members will have the opportunity to participate in a range of low cost or no cost recreational activities.
- BEGINNER OR ENTRY LEVEL PROGRAMS HEIGHTEN AWARENESS AND ENCOURAGE INVOLVEMENT IN NEW RECREATIONAL EXPERIENCES.
- GROUP PARTICIPATION PROVIDES OPPORTUNITIES FOR COMMUNITY MEMBERS TO INTERACT, WHICH IN TURN BENEFITS THE COMMUNITY AS A WHOLE.
  - Services which are for groups, rather than individuals, will receive higher levels of subsidization.
- THE PARTICIPATION OF PERSONS WITH ANY TYPE OF DISABILITIES IS VALUED AND ENCOURAGED. FACILITIES, PROGRAMS AND SERVICES WILL BE ACCESSIBLE.
- RECREATIONAL OR CULTURAL ACTIVITIES THAT PROMOTE GOOD HEALTH AND DISEASE PREVENTION THROUGH PHYSICAL ACTIVITY CONTRIBUTE TO THE WELL-BEING OF THE COMMUNITY.

### FEES AND CHARGES OPERATIONAL PRINCIPLES

WHILE IT IS RECOGNIZED THAT THE FEES AND CHARGES VALUE STATEMENTS WILL DETERMINE THE LEVEL OF SUBSIDIZATION WHICH EACH SERVICE AREA WILL RECEIVE, OPERATIONAL PRINCIPLES WILL GUIDE THE ACTUAL IMPLEMENTATION.

- THE ACTUAL COSTS OF A PARKS AND RECREATION SERVICE IS BASED ON AN APPROVED, CONSISTENT FORMULA AND THE COSTS WILL BE REFLECTED IN THE FEE.
- A FEE OR CHARGE WILL BE COMPARED TO OTHER SIMILAR MARKET PRICES TO ENSURE IT IS A FAIR MARKET PRICE. THE MARKET PRICE WILL REFLECT THE EFFECTS OF SUPPLY AND DEMAND ON THE SERVICE AREA.
- DIFFERENT FEES AND CHARGES WILL BE APPLIED DEPENDING ON THE DEMAND AS IT RELATES TO THE TIME OF DAY. NON-PRIME TIME OR PRIME TIME CHARGES WILL BE APPLIED IF THIS IS CONSISTENT WITH THE MARKET.
- CONSIDERATION WILL BE GIVEN TO OFFERING HIGHLY SUBSIDIZED SERVICES IN AREAS WHICH REQUIRE THEM DUE TO THE SOCIO-ECONOMIC CONDITIONS OF THE COMMUNITY.
