2006 MRN ROAD REHABILITATION

PURPOSE:

To obtain approval to award a contract for machine laid asphalt and asphalt

grinding.

RECOMMENDATION:

1. **THAT** a contract be awarded to the lowest bidder, Winvan Paving Ltd., for machine laid asphalt and asphalt grinding at various locations throughout Burnaby for a total cost \$1,849,484.30 with final payment based on actual quantities and unit prices tendered.

REPORT

Three tenders for this contract were received by the closing time of 3:00 p.m. Thursday, 2006 May 18 and were opened by staff in the presence of representatives of the firms bidding. The tenders received are as follows:

Winvan Paving Ltd.	\$1,849,484.30
Columbia Bitulithic a Division of Warren Materials Inc.	\$1,920,655.88
Jack Cewe Ltd.	\$1,979,714.00

The work of this contract involves the supply of all labour, materials, tools, plant and equipment required for the grinding of approximately 4,500 square meters of existing asphalt, the laying of approximately 11,300 tonnes of asphalt and other related works. The Director Engineering is of the opinion that the tenders received are competitive and reflective of current market conditions.

The recommended bidder, Winvan Paving Ltd., has satisfactorily completed numerous, similar projects for the City. The Director Engineering is satisfied that they have the experience and resources to complete the work of this contract.

The Director Engineering and our consultant, ISL Infrastructure Systems Ltd., concur with the above recommendation.
