COST SHARING AGREEMENT - METRO VANCOUVER

**PURPOSE:** 

To seek Council approval to enter into a cost sharing agreement with the Metro

Vancouver for watermain renewal on Morley/Berkley/6<sup>th</sup> St

## **RECOMMENDATIONS:**

**1. THAT** Council approve the expenditures of \$570,000 (inclusive of 6% GST) for watermain renewal on Morley/Berkley/6<sup>th</sup> St.

**2. THAT** the City Solicitor be authorized to prepare and execute a cost sharing agreement with the Metro Vancouver in the amount of \$570,000 (inclusive of 6% GST) for watermain renewal Morley/Berkley/6<sup>th</sup> St.

## REPORT

Metro Vancouver's 10-year Capital Plan includes provision for the replacement of their existing water supply trunk main that runs between Burnaby Heights Park and Westburnco Reservoir in New Westminster. The recently completed Phase I included sections that extended from the Burnaby Museum, along Sperling Ave, Buckingham Ave, Buckingham Dr and Stanley Cr. Phase II construction is planned for 2008 and includes sections on Morley/Berkley/6<sup>th</sup> St as shown in Figure 1.


As an integrated approach to infrastructure renewal and cost effectiveness, staff proposes a coordinated effort with Metro Vancouver to upgrade a City owned local distribution watermain and related road rehabilitation in an area impacted by Metro Vancouver's own trunk main renewal project. The specific sections are;

- Morley Dr, Berkley to Canada Way;
- Berkley St, Canada Way to 6<sup>th</sup> St (ROW);
- 6<sup>th</sup> St, Mayfield to Wedgewood St.

To: City Manager From: Director Engineering

This integrated approach will require the City to enter into a cost sharing agreement with the Metro Vancouver who will be responsible for managing the design and contract administration process. The City's share of the total project cost is estimated at \$570,000. Sufficient general revenue funds are available and these expenditures are included under the Water Utility component of the 2008 Provisional Financial Plan.
