**PURPOSE:** To obtain expenditure authorization to print and distribute the updated Burnaby Bike Map.

**RECOMMENDATION:**

1. **THAT** Council be requested to authorize an expenditure of \$2,400 from the Transportation Committee budget for the printing and distribution of the updated Burnaby Bike Map, as outlined in this report.

**REPORT****1.0 BACKGROUND**

The Burnaby Transportation Plan states that "... greater efforts must be made to promote alternative modes of transportation ...", including cycling. Since 1998, one of the means of achieving this has been the production and distribution of the Burnaby Bike Map. Updated annually to reflect the developing network, the Burnaby Bike Map:

- informs potential cyclists of safe routes for their journeys, and thus reduces barriers to cycling;
- encourages use of alternative modes resulting in the reduction of greenhouse gas emissions;
- provides related transit information to support multi-modal trips;
- is a resource that encourages exploration of the City's cycling network.

The Burnaby Bike Map is provided free to the public, and is available at City facilities including community and recreational centres, libraries, the Burnaby Tourist Information Centre at Metrotown, and City Hall. The map is also made available on the City's web site, and as one page of the Spring issue of InfoBurnaby (subject to availability of space). The map has been described as an "amazing document" by Momentum Magazine, the leading bicycle magazine in Greater Vancouver.

## 2.0 FINANCIAL

Based on previous usage patterns, it is proposed to print 8,000 copies of the map at a cost of \$2,400. It is proposed to fund this expenditure from the Boards, Committees and Commissions budget, as has been done in previous years. Sufficient operating funds are available in the budget for this purpose.

## 3.0 CONCLUSION

Updating the Burnaby Bike Map supports the alternative transportation goals of the Burnaby Transportation Plan and the Official Community Plan. It is therefore recommended that the Transportation Committee request Council expenditure approval for printing and distribution of the updated Burnaby Bike Map.
