#18/07 Community Centred College For the Retired

Recommendation:

1. THAT a grant in the amount of \$2,000 be awarded to the Community Centred College for the Retired in 2007.

An application was received requesting a grant to assist with the cost of courses and programs provided by the Community Centred College for the Retired. Twenty eight volunteer teachers provide over 30 classes in a variety of subjects including computers, languages and music.

REPORT

An application was received requesting a grant for the Crisis Centre's distress counselling line and suicide prevention training program. Over 1,780 distress line calls were received from Burnaby residents last year. For the current 2006/07 school year, the organization expects to complete 92 suicide prevention and stress management workshops for over 2,760 Burnaby high school students.

#21/07 SFU Childrens' Centre

RECOMMENDATION:

1. THAT this grant request be denied.

REPORT

The SFU Child Care Society is an independent non-profit organization. The Society has evolved into one of the largest child care providers in the Lower Mainland.

Currently, 296 people are waiting for toddler care at the SFU facility. With the opening of their Verdant program at UniverCity, SFU Childcare will increase toddler space capacity from 72 to 84. The opening of an additional fifty 3 – 5 age spaces in 2008/09 near the Verdant program at UniverCity will ensure that SFU Childcare remains financially secure. The Society is requesting a grant to support the expansion of SFU Childcare and the needs of the community.

Request: \$40,000 over a 2 year period CPA: 2006 – Nil
