An application was received from the Odyssey of the Mind team at Chaffey – Burke Elementary School requesting a grant to assist with the cost of sending the team to the Odyssey of the Mind World Finals to be held in Lansing, Michigan from May 22-27.

Odyssey of the Mind is an international program for kids of all ages that promotes creativity, logic and teamwork in a problem solving competition.

Request: Up to \$1300 CPA: 2006 - \$2,400 (\$150 x 16 students)

The Executive Committee of Council recommends that a grant in the amount of \$750 (\$150 x 5 students) be awarded to the Odyssey of the Mind team at Chaffey-Burke Elementary School to assist with the cost of sending the team to the 2007 Odyssey of the Mind World Finals.

The Association is now entering its 38th year of operation. Its purpose is to rehabilitate orphaned, injured and damaged wildlife and release it back into the wild. In 2006, the Wildlife Rescue Association admitted 2,700 animals.
