The Social Issues Committee, at its meeting held on 2008 June 12, received information regarding the conference to be hosted by the Council of Senior Citizens' Organizations of BC (COSCO) on Seniors Health, Housing and Income in a Global Age-Friendly Community to be held 2008 September 15 - 16 at the Richmond Inn, Richmond.
