# **RECOMMENDATIONS:**

- 1. **THAT** the expenditures of \$157,500 (including 5% GST) from the Deer Lake Water Quality Reserve be approved.
- 2. THAT the expenditure of \$420,000 (including 5% GST) from Gaming funds be approved.
- 3. THAT Council be requested to concur.

# **REPORT**

The Annual Capital Budget for Parks, Recreation and Cultural Services contains two projects to be funded from the Deer Lake Water Quality Reserve and Gaming funds. In order to enable work to proceed on the following projects, approval is requested to facilitate the work.

1. Deer Lake Park

\$150,000

- continued implementation of the Deer Lake Master Plan to include construction of a boardwalk, bridge, and gravel trail on the south side of the lake to connect to existing walkways. This will reduce creek bank erosion and keep users on the main raised trail.
- 2. Barnet Marine Park

\$400,000

 design development for the connecting pedestrian overpass, cycle walkway at the west end of the park and an elevated seawalk linking this overpass to the west end of Drummond's Walk

It is recommended that Council be requested to approve Deer Lake Water Quality Reserve and Gaming funds to facilitate the above work.
