NORLAND AVENUE ROAD RECONSTRUCTION – PHASE 3
PURPOSE: To obtain approval to award a contract for Norland Avenue Rehabilitation

RECOMMENDATION:

1. **THAT** a contract be awarded to the lowest bidder, GCL Contracting and Engineering Inc., for Norland Avenue Road Reconstruction, for a total cost \$2,491,051.00 with final payment based on actual quantities and unit prices tendered.

REPORT

Three tenders for this contract were received by the closing time of 3:00 p.m. Tuesday, 2008 June 10 and were opened by staff in the presence of representatives of the firms bidding. The tenders received are as follows:


GCL Contracting & Engineering Inc.	\$2,491,051.00
Jack Cewe Ltd.	\$2,644,582.50
Double M Excavating Ltd.	\$2,877,842.19

The work of this contract involves the supply of all labour, materials, tools, plant and equipment required for complete reconstruction of a 370m long section on Norland Avenue and repaving only of approximately 250 m of Norland Avenue. It is the Director Engineering's opinion that the lowest tenderer's price is competitive and reflective of the current market conditions.

The recommended bidder, GCL Construction and Engineering Inc., has completed several contracts for the City in the past to the satisfaction of the City and is presently completing contract #2006-29 and contract #2007-21 satisfactorily. The Director Engineering and our consultant, R.F. Binnie & Associates Ltd. concur with the above recommendation.

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Appearing elsewhere on the Council agenda for reconsideration and final adoption is a Capital Works Bylaw report seeking funding approval for this project. These expenditures are included in the Special Roads component of the 2008-2012 Annual Financial Plan.
