A request to use City streets for the 10th Annual “Do It for Dad Walk/Run” for prostate cancer on Sunday, 2008 June 15 has been received from Leah Lariviere of Surrey BC. Council approval is required by the Street & Traffic Bylaw.


A request to close and use Roberts St from Burnaby Lake Pavilion to Sperling Ave, Sperling Ave from Roberts to Glencarin Dr and Glencarin Dr to the end of the road has been received from Leah Lariviere for the 10th Annual “Do It for Dad Walk/Run” on Sunday 2008 June 15 from 10:30am to 12:30pm. The walk/run is one of their major fundraising activities for prostate disease and they hope to have approximately 800 participants for this year’s event.

The organizers are aware that approval is subject to the following conditions:

1. That the road closure be conducted under the supervision of one person as marshall or organizer.
2. That all participants be instructed to respect the rights and property of the individuals encountered en route.

3. That the road closure be covered with liability insurance in the minimum amount of \$2 million with the City of Burnaby named as co-insured, and that the insurance policy include a 30 day cancellation notice and a cross liability clause.
