REPORT

A request to use City streets for a convoy on BC Day, 2008 August 4 has been received from Maurice Guibord, Museum Programs Coordinator for Burnaby Village Museum. Council approval is required by the Street & Traffic Bylaw.

On BC Day, 2008 August 4, the Burnaby Village Museum will be holding a Salute to the Veterans Day, celebrating BC Veterans and commemorating the 55th anniversary of the end of the Korean War. At 9:30am, they will form a convoy of no more that 15 licensed restored military vehicles on site, to transport dignitaries from the Museum to the Korean War Veterans Memorial in Burnaby Central Park on Boundary Rd. There will be a ½ hour memorial ceremony to recognize the surviving veterans and then the convoy would return to the museum.


The convoy would start from the Burnaby Village Museum with RCMP escort on Deer Lake Ave heading westbound to Deer Lake Pky, left on Deer Lake Pky to Willingdon, left on Willingdon to Imperial, right on Imperial to Boundary and right on Boundary to Burnaby Central Park. The convoy would return going northbound on Boundary, right on Moscrop/Deer Lake Pky to Deer Lake Ave and right on Deer Lake Ave to Burnaby Village Museum. RCMP will control all traffic, at all signalized intersections to ensure an undisrupted free flow of the convoy. (see attached map).

Organizers are aware that approval is subject to the following conditions:

1. That the convoy be conducted under the supervision of one person as marshall or organizer.
2. That all participants be instructed to respect the rights and property of the individuals encountered en route.
3. City of Vancouver's approval must be obtained for the brief traffic disruptions along Boundary Rd.

As this is a City event, liability insurance is not required.

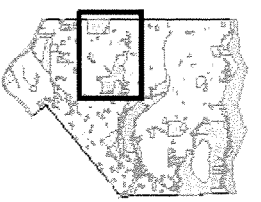

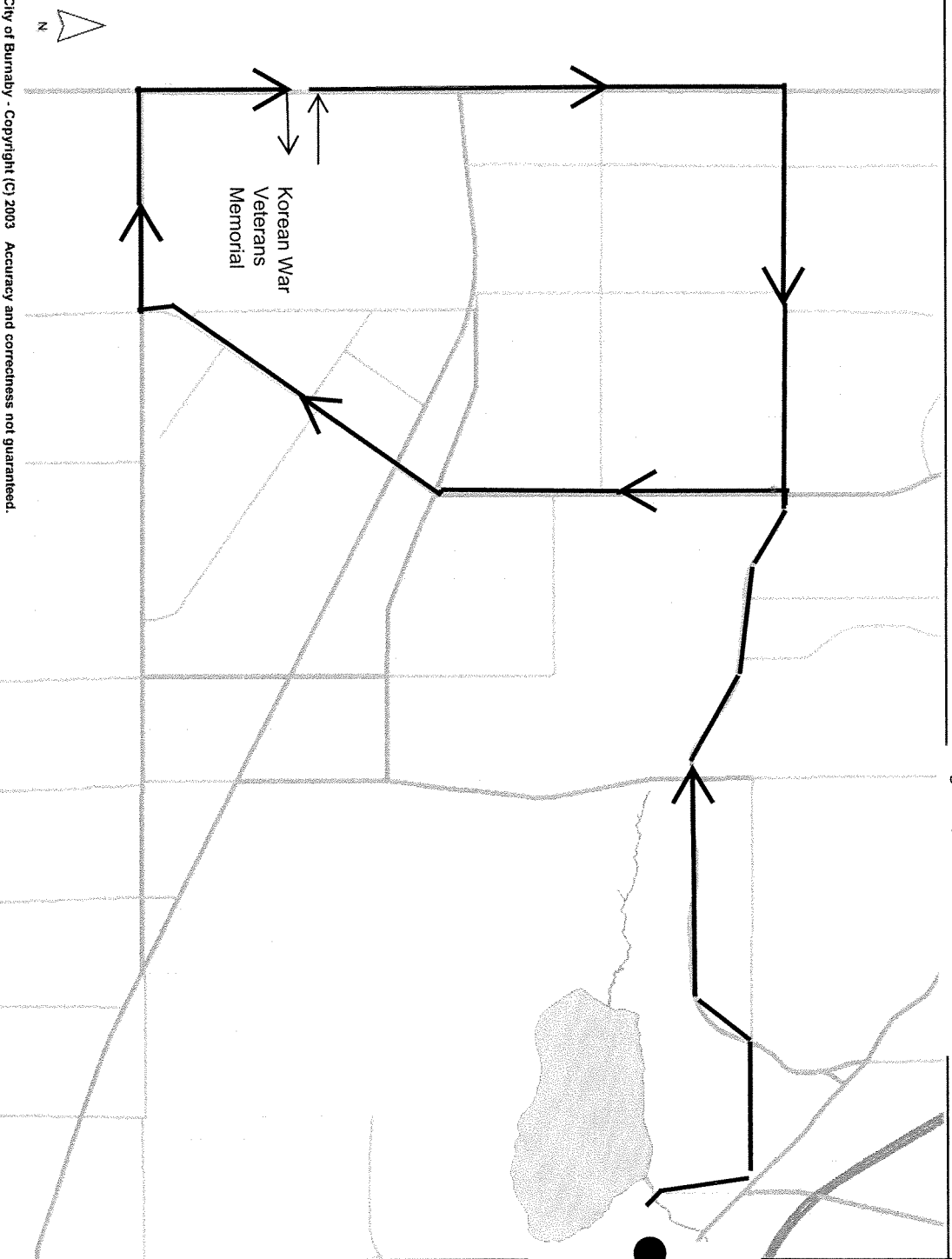
