RECOMMENDATIONS:

- 1. **THAT** the expenditure of \$515,000 from the 2008 Provisional Capital Budget for four projects as outlined in this report be approved.
- 2. THAT Council be requested to bring down a bylaw to appropriate \$540,750 (inclusive of 5% GST) from Capital Reserves to finance these projects.

REPORT

The 2008 Provisional Capital Budget for Parks, Recreation and Cultural Services contains the following four projects to be funded from Capital Reserves. To enable work to proceed on the following projects, approval is requested to bring down a bylaw for funding.

1. Tennis Courts

\$90,000

Continuation of improvements, repair and painting to Central Park, Ron McLean and Keswick tennis courts.

2. Burnaby Heights Parks

\$200,000

Replace vandalized playground and provide for the design for future redevelopment of the park.

3. Forest Management

\$150,000

Continue implementation plans for Central Park and Capitol Hill areas; Wildfire management; hazardous tree removal; tree planting and tree maintenance.

4. Trails

\$75,000

Maintenance, repair and replacement of various foot bridges, stairways and retaining walls within the parks trail system (Burnaby Mountain, Robert Burnaby, Ron McLean).
