5. **NEW BUSINESS**

Councillor Jordan

Councillor Jordan referred to Item (J), UBCM Executive Highlights from the Council Correspondence package dated 2007 January 04 regarding a proposal to rewrite the Public Health Act. Councillor Jordan noted that she does not

recall seeing any information on this matter and asked that staff investigate and circulate information to Council.

Councillor Jordan advised that she was in receipt of an email from Mr. Fabian concerning freeway construction in Houston and requesting she share the pictures (comparing them to construction on Willingdon) with Council.

Councillor Rankin

Councillor Rankin noted concern about outstanding issues related to the proposed road expansion related to the Gateway Project, particularly in consideration that Burnaby has not signed a Memorandum of Understanding with the Province in this regard. Councillor Rankin inquired what our status is regarding these outstanding issues and is there a plan for Council to meet with the Ministry should discussions not proceed.

The Director Planning & Building advised that there is ongoing communication with Ministry staff on the outstanding technical issues related to the project and will also be meeting with them to discuss the whole Program; a first meeting has been scheduled, but has not yet taken place. Should staff feel there is no movement in their discussions with the Ministry they will report back to Council to seek direction.

Councillor Evans

Councillor Evans inquired what the amount of claim for damages being sought from the City in the law suit from Kinder Morgan and Trans Mountain Pipe Line.

The City Solicitor advised there is not amount specified in the write but the claim is for general damages, recovery of costs and damage to their reputation.

Councillor Volkow

Councillor Volkow welcomed Dave Ellenwood as the new Director, Parks Recreation and Cultural Services.

Mayor Corrigan joined Councillor Volkow in welcoming Mr. Ellenwood who has just been appointed the Director Parks, Recreation and Cultural Services and advised that Mr. Ellenwood had previously been the Assistant Directors – Strategic & Business Planning in the Parks Department.

Councillor Dhaliwal

Councillor Dhaliwal noted that Canadians can again be proud of a gold medal win at the World Junior Hockey Championships and suggested the Mayor write a letter of congratulations to both the team and to the two team members who have a close association with the City of Burnaby.
