SUBJECT: **TRANSPORT & DISPOSAL OF SURPLUS EXCAVATED
MATERIALS FROM THE NORLAND AVENUE TRANSFER SITE**
PURPOSE: To obtain approval to award a contract for transport and disposal of surplus materials.

RECOMMENDATION:

1. **THAT** a contract for a one year period with options for up to four annual renewals be awarded to the lowest bidder, D & S Bulldozing, for transport and disposal of surplus excavated materials from the Norland Avenue transfer site for a total estimated cost of \$440,055.00 with final payment based on actual quantities and unit prices tendered.

REPORT

Eleven tenders for this contract, ranging from \$440,055.00 to \$1,850,625.00 were received by the closing time of 3:00 p.m. Thursday, 2009 April 30 and were opened by City staff.

The City collects surplus excavated materials from various construction sites to a temporary storage bin situated in the Norland Avenue Transfer Site. The work of this contract involves transporting surplus excavated materials to an approved permanent disposal site.

The recommended bidder, D & S Bulldozing, has satisfactorily completed similar projects based on validation of references supplied. The Director Engineering is satisfied that they have the experience and resources to complete the work of this contract. The Director Engineering concurs with the above recommendation.

Funding is available within various operating and capital work orders in annual operating and capital budgets.
