**SUBJECT: CAPITAL BUDGET FUNDING REQUEST**

**RECOMMENDATION:**

1. **THAT** Council be requested to approve the appropriation of Gaming Funds in the amount of \$157,500 (inclusive of 5% GST) for the project outlined in this report.

**REPORT**

The 2009 Annual Capital Budget for Parks, Recreation and Cultural Services contains the following project to be funded from Gaming Funds. To enable work to proceed, approval is requested to appropriate gaming funds for the project:

1. **Public Art Commission** **\$150,000**

This is to commission a work of public art for installation on City land as the Burnaby component of the "Necklace Project" - an inter-municipal collaboration involving thematically-linked municipally-funded public art works creating the "beads" in the "necklace". Current commitments by the 10 participating cities are valued at about \$1 million for the art installations planned for completion on or about the 2010 Games.

The 2009 Annual Capital Budget for Parks, Recreation & Cultural Services contains funding in the amount of \$150,000 to provide for this project.

It is recommended that Council be requested to approve the appropriation of Gaming Funds in the amount of \$157,500 (inclusive of 5% GST) to proceed with the project.
