REPORT

A. **BACKGROUND**

Each spring Commission receives a report outlining the recommended fee structure for the upcoming year's Recreation and Cultural services. Fees are established at this time to enable staff to better project revenues during the Provisional Budget process. As well, the new 2009/2010 rates will be advertised in the Fall/Winter Leisure Guide, to be distributed in August.

Market research has been done throughout the Lower Mainland on comparable admission and allotment rates, and program fees and services to ensure the City of Burnaby fees remain reasonable and competitive. Based on this research and analysis, and considering the Finance Department's inflationary projections, it is recommended that there be a 2.5% overall increase applied to most 2009/2010 Bylaw and Non Bylaw fees. The exceptions to this increase are in areas that have experienced market fluctuations or in areas that have seen significantly increased costs. These exceptions are detailed later in this report.

In 1997, Commission approved Value Statements and Operating Principles that outline a pricing framework, and give guidance to staff when establishing fees and charges. All fee proposals are guided by these documents.

To simplify cash handling, the current practice of rounding single admission rates will be continued. Single admissions are typically under \$10.00 and are frequently paid in cash. Rounding of the remaining fees is not considered as critical as these are typically paid by debit or credit card.

Two documents are produced each year as part of the fees and charges process. The Facility Use Fee Schedule establishes fees and charges related to admissions and allotments and the Program and Services Fees document establishes rates for programs and services.

B. FEES DOCUMENTS

1. Facility Use Fee Schedule

This document covers all fees and charges related to admissions and allotments for Recreation and Cultural Services. The Community Charter requires Council to approve these fees through the enactment of bylaws.

All of the fees and charges in the 2009/2010 Facility Use Fee Schedule will receive a 2.5% increase except for the fees highlighted below:

i. Increases Above 2.5%

The following fees are currently below the mid market range so will receive an increase above 2.5%:

ii. New Fees

iii. Maintain Current Fee or Fee Reduction

In addition, with fair and competitive fees, sufficient revenue is generated to offset inflationary increases.
