**SUBJECT: BURNABY LAKE REJUVENATION PROJECT - RAMSAY CREEK IN-
STREAM ENHANCEMENT**

PURPOSE: To request approval for the appropriation of Gaming Funds for Ramsay Creek In-stream Enhancement Works


RECOMMENDATION:

1. **THAT** approval be given for the appropriation of Gaming Funds in the amount of \$200,000 for Ramsay Creek In-stream Enhancement Works.

REPORT

As a component of the Burnaby Lake Rejuvenation Project, in-stream enhancement works are being planned to be undertaken this summer in Ramsay Creek which is a tributary stream to Burnaby Lake. These compensatory works will result in stabilization of localized eroding stream banks, enhancement of in-stream habitat complexity, re-establishment of a defined fish migration route from lentic to lotic habitats, and enhancement of rearing habitat values.

The cost for the design, tender preparation, construction, supervision and contingency is estimated to be \$200,000. Given the environmental nature of the work, it is requested that gaming Funds in the amount of \$200,000 be approved by Council for the noted work. These improvements are not included in the previously approved funding for Burnaby Lake Rejuvenation Project dredging work.
