REPORT

A request to use City streets for the 16th Annual Alta Vista Park Community Picnic on Saturday, 2009 September 19 has been received from Sandra Banero, Program Coordinator of Bonsor Recreation Complex. Council approval is required by the Street & Traffic Bylaw.

The City of Burnaby Parks, Recreation and Cultural Services Department, in conjunction with a large contingent of volunteer residents, is planning to hold a community picnic at Alta Vista Park. This annual event is intended to build and maintain community spirit and provide an informal opportunity for fun. Residents of all ages from the immediate neighbourhood are able to enjoy a variety of family activities while meeting and socializing with their neighbours. Some of the organizations that partake in this event include Burnaby Parks, Recreation and Cultural Services, community art and recreation stations, balloon twisting, mini golf, face painting, Byrne Creek Stream Keepers, and the Burnaby Fire Department.

This event requires the closure of a portion of the 5100 block of McKee St (see attached map) between the hours of 9am and 3pm.

As this is a City event, liability insurance is not required.
