DEER LAKE PARK - DEMOLITION OF CITY OWNED STRUCTURE,

BVM DALE 4, AT 6501 DEER LAKE AVENUE

RECOMMENDATION:

1. THAT Council be requested to authorize the sale for moving or salvage or demolition of the city owned structure, the Burnaby Village Museum Dale 4 Building, at 6501 Deer Lake Avenue.

REPORT

Implementation of Burnaby Village Museum (BVM) rural zone plan and Deer Lake Brook bridge construction is scheduled for 2009/2010. To facilitate this BVM site development project, the storage building known as Dale 4, located at 6501 Deer Lake Avenue, is required to be removed and/or demolished. The Dale 4 structure is a former residential dwelling previously addressed 5111 Dale Avenue, which was acquired for inclusion in Deer Lake Park in 1970. As illustrated in the attached sketch (Attachment #1), the subject property is located on the east bank of Deer Lake Brook at the south edge of the Burnaby Village Museum precinct within Deer Lake Park.

Heritage Planning staff have assessed the dwelling and have concluded that there is no heritage value associated with the building.

Funding in the amount of \$75,000 is included in the 2009-2013 Annual Capital Program and a funding expenditure bylaw was approved by Commission and Council in May 2009 for this demolition, including asbestos removal, fence replacement and riparian landscape restoration.


