RECOMMENDATIONS:

- 1. THAT the expenditure of \$50,000 from the 2009 Annual Capital Budget for the project in this report be approved.
- 2. THAT Council be requested to bring down a bylaw to appropriate \$52,500 (inclusive of 5% GST) from Capital Reserves to finance this project.

REPORT

The current Eastburn Community Centre will be demolished in late spring 2010 when the construction of the new Edmonds Aquatic and Community Centre begins. The majority of the existing Eastburn services will be re-located to the vacated Kingsway Library site.

This temporary site provides an opportunity to expand the current small weight/fitness area and provide an enhanced service leading up to the opening of the new facility which will include a good sized fitness/weight component. Staff view the weight and cardio space at the old Kingsway Library site as an opportunity to grow this service area prior to the opening of the new facility.

Life Fitness is offering a 35% discount on exercise equipment that is being used by the athletes during the 2010 Olympics. This is a special post Olympic discount program from VANOC. The selection of equipment has been reserved by staff from Life Fitness subject to funding approval. The value of this equipment is \$49,610. In order to take advantage of this 35% discount, prepayment is required by 2009 December 31. Delivery of the equipment would be in April 2010.

Sufficient Capital Reserves are available to complete the above project in the 2009 Annual Capital Budget.
